

Rural Valley Borough Council Minutes
July 14, 2014

Meeting opened by President William Spera with flag pledge.

Randy Arduini moved to accept the Hagar Paving bid for \$49,145.25. Frank Palilla seconded. Motion carried.

Linda Ziembicki gave update on standing of the old bank building. Council must wait for a hearing date first. If Joe Wright does not show up for hearing, he will be guilty and then Borough can file criminal actions. Mr. Wright can appeal. It will probably be another month before the hearing.

Randy Arduini moved to accept the June 9, 2014, minutes with corrections. Tony Arduini seconded. Minutes approved.

Kathy Fusaro moved to accept the Treasurer's report. Tony Arduini seconded. Treasurer's report accepted.

Clifford Nichols moved to pay the bills presented. Jeff Dorsey seconded. Motion carried.

Correspondence read.

Mike & Mary Koma had concerns about the Memorial and the lines at Lite-Up Nite. Council had already decided not to have this event at the Park.

Tony Arduini moved to approve Apollo Borough as a new member in UCC. Jeff Dorsey seconded. Motion carried.

Committees:

Mayor:

- Police report and Ordinance Officer report given.
- Ordinance Officer and/or Police Officer need to look at sidewalks for grass debris. Also need to look at trees over roadway on Schlemmer.
- Randy Arduini moved to approve the closing of Main Street from Washington Ave. to Line St. and Line St. From Main to 85 By Pass on Friday, July 25, 2014, from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. for parade. Also approved closing of Line Street to Main Street and Main Street to Washington Avenue from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. on Saturday, July 26, 2014. Clifford Nichols seconded motion. Motion carried.
- Randy Arduini moved to hire Josh Krizmanich as a part-time police officer. Kathy Fusaro seconded. Motion carried.

Water & Sewage:

- Water report given.
- Kathy Fusaro moved to purchase an air conditioner for the Borough Building. Tony Arduini seconded. Motion carried.
- Kathy Fusaro spoke to Lee Calarie, former solicitor; and he suggested that Council adopt a Landlord Ordinance. Secretary is to call Kittanning to see if a copy of theirs can be obtained.
- Denny Marken is getting water in garage from waterline. Will check to see if 2 years is up since water lines installed.

Communications:

- Tony Arduini has the new website up and running.
- Tony Arduini moved to purchase a Security Camera System with 4 cameras for approximately \$280. Jeff Dorsey seconded. Motion carried.

Streets:

- Dan Hill is requesting to pour a cement pad on his property that will also go over onto the Borough's right of way. Council agrees to give him permission to pour the pad; however, if for any reason the Borough has to dig the area, the Borough does not have any responsibility to repair/replace this pad.
- Plans are to rent a tar buggy and have Jeff and Kevin fill all the cracks on Main Street. Rental would be approximately \$1,000.
- Randy asked for a thank you to be sent to Andy Firment at PennDot for their help on clearing a pipe in the Borough.

Equipment:

- Jeff will look at backhoe for reported noise in rear. Truck may need springs replaced and ABS in police car.
- Kenny Ross price for truck \$35,280/\$22,674 needs explained. Day Chev. \$26,326. Allegheny Ford \$25,914. Table till next month.
- Might join a Town Meeting with Neighborhood Watch meeting sometime in September.

- Making progress on dug outs.

Other:

- Talked to Terry Rupp on Landfill. Need to talk to solicitor as to trial.
- Davidson house is not ready for a walk through.
- Frank Palilla moved to permit Rural Rascals Day Care owned by Alia Boyer to use the SV Lodge for the children in case of an emergency. Cliff Nichols seconded. Motion carried.
