

Parking in Rural Valley Borough

This is a reminder to everyone that the parking restrictions in the Pa. Motor Vehicle Code are in effect in the Borough of Rural Valley, as they are on every street, or road in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The Parking Ordinance enacted in Rural Valley Borough is in addition to the restrictions in the Pa. Motor Vehicle Code.

CHAPTER 460 Parking

460.01	Special restriction for Main Street.	460.99	Penalty.
460.02	Parking prohibited in certain locations.		

460.01 SPECIAL RESTRICTION FOR MAIN STREET.

To conserve parking space, any vehicle parked on Main Street shall be parked within four feet of any other vehicle parked on the same side of Main Street in the immediate vicinity. (Ord. 68. Passed 4-28-30.)

AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 460.01

Re: Special Restrictions for Main Street

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Rural Valley an Amendment Ordinance establishing parking restrictions for parking on Main Street in the Borough. The following language shall be added to the existing Ordinance Number 460.01:

No vehicle shall remain in the same parking place on Main Street for more than 72 hours.

460.02 PARKING PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS.

Parking shall be prohibited at all times in the following locations:

(b)	Main Street	South	From corner of Line Street 41 feet east on Main Street

AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 460.02

Re: Parking Prohibited in Certain Locations

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Rural Valley an Amendment Ordinance dealing with restricted parking in certain locations. The following addition shall be made to Ordinance Number 460.02:

Parking shall be prohibited during the months of November to April in the following locations:

460.99 PENALTY.

ENACTMENT OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 460.03

**Re: AN ORDINANCE BY THE BOROUGH OF RURAL VALLEY, COUNTY OF
ARMSTRONG, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING
TIME LIMITS FOR PARKING IN THE BOROUGH OF RURAL VALLEY**

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Rural Valley, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

460.03 PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN BUSINESS HOURS

- (a) Eligibility: Parking on Main Street can be limited to one or two hours in front of businesses with frontage on Main Street.
- (b) Permit Application: Permits may be picked up at the Borough Office during regular business hours of the Borough, or, may be printed online from the Borough website.
- (c) Review of Application: (i) All applications for Time Limit Parking will be reviewed at the regularly scheduled Borough meeting in the month immediately following the month in which the application for Time Limited Parking Permits is dated and turned into the Borough; (ii) Applicants will be notified within five business days of acceptance or denial of the application; and, (iii) Hours of time limited parking will be established by Borough Council after review of the application.
- (d) Appeals of denial of Application: Appeals will be heard at the discretion of the Borough Council.
- (e) Signs: If an application for Time Limited Parking is approved by the Borough Council, the business owner is responsible for the purchase of the sign from the Borough, and the sign may be permanent or temporary; in the case of temporary signs, the business owner, operator, or manager is responsible for the placement and removal of the sign on a daily basis.
- (f) Failure to Adhere to Permit Restrictions: If a business owner, after the issuance of a time limit parking permit, elects to use a temporary sign, and then fails to adhere to the terms of the permit, the permit may be withdrawn.
- (g) Installation of Sign: If a permit is approved and issued to a business, the sign will be reviewed by the Borough prior to the installation of the sign, and no sign shall be installed unless, and until, the Borough approves its location.
- (h) Penalties for Failure to Obey Time Limited Parking Area: If a vehicle is parked in a Time Limited parking permit area for longer than the time allowed for parking in that area, then the following penalties shall apply:
 - i. First Offense: Warning
 - ii. Second Offense: Fine, as set forth in Section 460.99 below
 - iii. Third and Subsequent Offenses: The vehicle will be towed from the Time Limited Area, at the owner's expense.

AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 1025

Re: Snow and Ice Removal

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Rural Valley an Amendment Ordinance dealing with restricted parking in certain locations. The following addition shall be made to Ordinance Number 1025:

1025.05 Street Plowing

All vehicles must be removed from all Borough streets within twenty four hours of a snowfall for the plowing of streets.
