Committees:

***Water:***

- Water report given.
- Lines will be flushed this week.
- Met with Ken Howard going over all needs for water for possible grant.
- New pumps in. Start up on 24<sup>th</sup>.
- Tom Staley is going to run needed water tests.

***Waste Management***

- Kathy Fusaro moved to schedule clean-up day on Thursday, May 25. Randy Arduini seconded. Motion carried.

***Public Safety:***

- Cameras still need installed at Borough Building. Need some holes drilled. Randy Arduini and Kevin will work on the installation.
- Kevin is to check on the cameras at the park to make sure all is working. Will report at next meeting.
- Police need to check the park cameras.
- Discussed purchase of police car at Tri-Star. Ford Taurus for \$25,364 price. First National has 4 yr loan with a payment \$6,667.49, 4 yr annual, bank fee \$400 First payment and fee due at signing. Secretary will check budget.
- ***Streets:***
- Randy Arduini moved to close Main Street on Good Friday from 11 to "when walk is finished" from the Methodist Church to the S Turn. Frank Palilla seconded. Motion carried.
- Kevin and Randy are now certified for Dirt & Gravel Roads. Either Kevin, Randy or Lou must be present when Schlemmer is being worked on.
- Roads will be swept in near future.
- Bridge on East Parkwood needs some patching work.

***Building/Maintenance:***

- Cheapest bid for painting roof of large metal pole building is from Lee Miller at \$5,400. Secretary will check budget to see how this can fit.
- Larry Walker suggested purchasing a winch, especially needed for moving salt box on/off truck. Council agreed. Price is around \$300.
- Randy moved to reimburse Tim Watterson \$500 for his work done on the Palmer Trailer. Cliff Nichols seconded. Motion carried.

***Park:***

- SV Rec. Commission is concerned about grass cutting, as Dave is willing to help some but not all. Dave didn't think Kevin would have time. Kevin is to have Ken McClafferty use the mower at park to see if he would be capable to do mowing.

***Other:***

- Ordinance problems needing addressed by police:
  - Dumpster at old Dixon residence needs emptied.
  - Szul residents on Main are throwing garbage waste on side of house.
  - Paula Colton residence has back porch totally filled with junk.
  - Dog biting people at Nagy rental.
- Police officer on duty during weekdays needs to be officer working on ordinances.
- Community Action has someone who needs work. Will try out.
- Christmas lighting needs work.
