610--Animals-Running at large-including must be firmly secured by means of collar, chain or other device.

Adding-Limiting number of cats/dogs household to total of 4

460--Parking--No Parking Cowanshannock changing West to East.

Main by S turn--No parking from corner of Birch St. & Main, 350 west on Main

Adding Center Street, both East & West, from School and Center to Center and Main.

Adding Locust both East and West, all the way.

Changing penalties on parking to "no less than \$25 to no more than \$100"

1025--Snow & Ice Removal: Penalties changed "no less than \$25 to no more than \$100"

661--Vegetation: Penalties changed "no less than \$25 to no more than \$100"

660--Safety, Sanitation, Health:

660.02 on keeping swine revised to: No person shall maintain any farm building or keep any farm animals--pigs, cows, horses, chickens, goats, etc.--within 500 feet of Main, First, Parkwood, Locust, Diane, Shannock, and Pine.

Repeal: 260.03 Life Ins & Health coverage, 1420 old flood hazard, 220.02 absence from meetings, 660.06 smoking in school district, 248.01 SV Regional Police
