October 8, 2018

Meeting opened by President Will Spera with flag pledge.

Brian Myers and Charles Boyer addressed Council concerning business parking area in front of their business. Frank Palilla moved to permit business parking signed areas as codified in the Borough Ordinance in front of Carson/Boyer, the fire department, and the magistrate's office. Jon Nagy seconded. Motion carried.

Kevin and Kim Nelson addressed Council concerning water run off going onto their daughter Kylie's property. The problem seems to be larger drainage pipes running into smaller ones. Employees are working on it.

Mayor:

- Police report given.
- Randy Arduini moved to close Main Street from the fire department to Cowanshannock Ave. on October 27, from 1 p.m. until Halloween parade is over and to permit trick or treating in the Borough from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. Tony Arduini seconded. Motion carried.

Water:

- Water report not available as banks were closed today.
- Kathy Fusaro is to meet with Kim Nelson, as reports are needed that can't seem to be prepared for us.
- Grant for \$196,213 has been obtained with our matching 15%.

Streets:

- If Shannock Avenue is turned over to Borough, Dirt & Gravel grant could be applied for. It must meet Penn Dot specs first.
- Township did not do any seal coating.
- In Pipe Line Project water lines were broken and a gas line. Need billed for 3 valves and extra borough time can be taken from Highway Aid. County approved project and signed off.
- Need to budget for drainage problems.

Equipment:

- Need emergency lights on trucks for winter
- Ford 250—not sure whether it will be totaled or repaired. Randy Arduini moved to either repair or replace the Ford 250 ASAP. Frank Palilla seconded. Motion carried.

Other:

- Light up Nite on Friday, Nov. 23. Will check to see if it can be in Pete Kaplon's yard. Possibly will have decorating contest event. Jon Nagy and Tony Arduini are working on it.
- Budget meeting will be November 5. Secretary will publish date.
- Resume' for secretary/treasurer position due by Oct. 31.
